SF12v12 Scoring

The responses to the SF12v2 questionnaire were scored by Optum.

Health Domain Scales: Eight domain scales were derived to represent the degree of impairment reported by the participant in eight health domains: physical functioning, role participation with physical health problems (role physical), bodily pain, general health, vitality, social functioning, role participation with emotional health problems (role emotional), and mental health. Each scale has a range from 0-100.

Component Summary Measures: The two component summary measures—Physical Component Summary (PCS) and Mental Component Summary (MCS)—provide reliable and valid summaries of a respondent or group's physical and mental health status, respectively. These measures take into account not only the physical or psychological limitations, but also self-evaluation of current health. Both summary measures rely on each of the 8 health domain scales.

Norm Based Scoring (NBS): Simple linear T-score transformation was used to transform the 8 health domain scales and the two component summary measures so scores would be comparable to the 2009 SF12v2 general US population normative data (mean =50; standard deviation = 10). Thus, scores above 55 and below 45 can be considered above and below the average, respectively, in the 2009 US general population.

Missing items: Missing items were not imputed using the Quality Metric Missing Score Estimation (MSE). Scores for the two-item health domain scales (PF, RP, RE, MH) were still derived with one input item missing, while the single-item scales (BP, GH, VT, SF) will be missing if the input item is missing. The component summary measures will be missing if any response to one of the SF12v2 questions was missing.
